What will we learn this week?

Reading strategies

Scholars will read <u>A Musical Day</u> from their Journeys book. Scholars will learn to identify the elements of a realistic fiction text. We will work on retelling a story using the sequence of events. Use this sentence starter to help with this skill: "First..., next...., last...." We will learn about what a narrator is and what they do. We will practice the short o sound in more complex words as well as blends that have the letter I such as flop and clock.

Spelling Words (Make flashcards)

on, got, fox, flop, not, hop, slot, her, now, our

Challenge: block, clock, clog, would

High Frequency and Vocabulary Words

HFW: her, now, our, she, today, would Vocabulary: aunt, band, guitars, music (Scholars should be able to read their HFW independently. Create flash cards to assist with this.)

Oral Vocabulary

faraway, village, crisp, smudge, peeked, edges

Grammar

Scholars will learn about informative writing through the creation of a thank you note. We will also learn about what makes a sentence a statement.

Math

Scholars will finish up our unit of subtraction strategies and begin talking about solving equation with an unknown such as 2+__=5

Vocabulary: unknown partner, label, story problem

Social Studies

We will continue our unit on citizenship. We will be talking about rules at school and laws in the community.

<u>Vocabulary</u>: self-control, self reflection, community helper, occupation

<u>Science</u> We will continue our unit on living things and their life cycles with a focus on plants.

<u>Vocabulary</u>: life cycle, plants, animals, seeds, seedling, adult
